Pokaiņi forest is a new and unusual touristic site 13 kilometers from the town of Dobele in the direction of Īle. The forest, full of small hills and little valleys, is known for an unusually picturesque landscape. But the main reason that attracts visitors is the miraculous tales that are being told about the forest. Here lie the famous Pokaiņi stone stacks, in smaller and bigger groups, forming stone rivers and little stone dykes. Such an amount of stones of all shapes and sizes indeed creates an extraordinary impression. Many people even claim to have felt a kind of energy running through them, some see visions and some claim to have received some information flow. Guides and visitors of the forest talk about rare natural phenomena, however sages, healers and psychics consider this to be an ancient sanctuary. Even if previous experience and lack of scientific explanations stops the belief in supernatural wonders, the calm of the surroundings and a tranquil walk in the fresh air will cheer up any skeptical mind. Don't forget comfortable shoes as the hilly Pokaiņi forest walk is also popular among orienteering sports fans.

Part of Jurmala, connected with the rest of Jurmala and Riga by and electric railway and the Riga-Ventspils highway. 44 km from Riga.

Kemeri is 6 km far from the sea, and is situated among lakes and swamps, rich in sulfuric springs. Kemeri region with its curative qualities of sulphur springs is well known since 18th century, but the official year of establishing Kemeri state resort is 1838, when the first medical bathing house was built there. In 1928 Kemeri gained city rights.

That is why the development of this place is connected to medical functions of sulfuric waters of local marshes.

Saint source of Kemeri, used in folk medicine, have been known to doctors from the second half of the 18th — the beginning of the 19th century, when representatives of Kurland high society came there to get rid of various diseases. They were accepted by foresters, who offered to live in their houses and enjoy medical baths from marsh springs. The name of one forester was Kemers; he gave the name to marshes and later, to the whole resort.

There are more than 30 sulphureous springs on the territory of Kemeri, besides, there are a lot of medical peat and sapropelic silt (in the lake Kaniera).

In 1997, Kemeri National Park was founded here.



Date and Place

- Event takes place on the Easter Monday 9 April 2012 in Riga.
- Location Pārdaugava, Uzvaras parks. Exact location of the event will be disclosed in the Bulletin 3.

Classes

According to the Trail-O rules there is no classification by age or gender.

- Paralympic Class: competitors who have some permanent physical disability (including hidden disabilities) which gives a significant disadvantage in Foot Orienteering competitions.
- **Open Class:** any competitor regardless gender, age or physical ability.

Courses, Starting Order, Punching

- Trail-O course, free starting order.
 - Starting interval min 1 minute.
 - Starting interval between teammates min 2 minutes.
- Needle punching on special Trail-O control cards.

Event Programme

Arrival, registration (competitors are only allowed in the Event Center and Warm-up area before the start).
Start in free order
Start for Foot-O Sprint competitors who have entered also the Trail-O competition
Prize giving ceremony

Terrain and Map

- **Terrain:** park, streets, yards.
- Map: made in 2011–2012, map specification **ISSOM-2007**, scale 1:4000, contours 2m.

Dangerous Areas

• When crossing the streets, please, make sure there is no traffic!

- Basic entry fee for competitors, who register till 5 April, and pay entry fee on the day of competition by cash (free of charge for Paralympic class).
- Discounted entry fee for competitors who register and pay entry fee by bank transfer to <u>the bank</u> account of OK Mona till 5 April.
- Late entry fee for competitors who have missed the entry deadline of 5 April.

Prizes

- **Certificate** and **prize** to the winners of first three places in each class.
 - In the **Open** class, also Paralympic class competitors are ranked.

Special Rules

- Competitors participate at their own risk.
- The Clubs shall arrange escorts for their team members who need physical assistance because of their disability.
- Competitors are not allowed in the competition area before the start; competitors are only allowed in the Event Center and warm-up area before the start.
- Competitors who have finished their courses may not contact competitors who have not started yet!

Other Specific information

 Foot-O sprint competition will take place at the same time; there will be Foot-O controls in the competition area – however, not a part of any Trail-O course.
