Target group

The IOF Foot Orienteering Commission and Rules Commission welcome you to an IOF Event Advisers' Clinic in La Marina (Alicante), Spain.

The Event Advisers' Clinic is organized for the education and recruitment of new IOF licensed Foot Orienteering Event Advisers. National orienteering federations are asked to identify and enter suitable candidates. Attendance at a clinic such as this is a key requirement for accreditation as an IOF Event Adviser.

The clinic is also open for experienced organizers who want to play major roles in organizing future high level IOF events (WOC, World Cup, WMOC, EYOC, WRE, etc.) but do not necessarily want to become an Event Adviser.

The requirements for licensing are:

1. Be an active foot orienteer.
2. Have competed in countries other than your own.
3. Have successfully controlled major national events in the last 3 years.
4. Be competent to communicate with IOF and the organizing Federation (mainly in English).
5. Have attended, and have been an active participant in an IOF Event Advisers Clinic
6. Be familiar with the IOF Rules and other relevant publications
7. Be recognized as a top standard controller/event adviser and endorsed as suitable by your Federation.

The clinic language is English.

Entries

The entry should be endorsed by the participant's National Federation by e-mail. Please use the entry form that will be available on the [IOF Webpage](#) from 16st September 2022.

1. Participant checks with his/her Federation that they will endorse the participation
2. Participant fills in the whole entry form and e-mails this form to their Federation contact
3. Federation endorses by forwarding participant's e-mail to tar-kar@outlook.com
4. IOF FootO Commission processes the entry and confirms to participant and Federation

The entry form should include the following information for each participant:

- Name
- Federation
- E-mail address
- Mobile phone number
- Summary of event organizing experience (course setting, controlling, event director, etc.)



Entry deadline

- 7th November 2022

Payment

The entry fee for the Clinic is 100,- EUR. The amount shall be paid by bank transfer (See entry form). Cash on site at the registration (Friday morning) in TRY or EUR. This option can be selected only if accommodation was not ordered. Otherwise, it is necessary to pay by bank transfer in advance. A receipt will be issued on request.

The entry fee covers:

- participation in the Clinic
- lunch on Saturday and Sunday (please indicate any food allergies in the entry form)

Accommodation

Hotel accommodation will be offered at the Clinic site, <https://costablancaexplore.com/>, within walking distance of orienteering maps. For those who need accommodation, the entry deadline is 24th October 2022. Reservation shall be done via the entry form.
